Consistent, improved sound quality

Tapes wear out. Digital recording media doesn't. So not only is the recording on digital going to be of a higher quality than analogue, but each duplicate file is going to be of exactly the same high quality as the original.

Security backups

Because digital files are so easily copied, it's a simple matter to keep a 'safety copy' on your local PC. Or an archive copy for longer term security. Tapes can get lost and can be overwritten in error. Once properly backed up, digital files are safe.

Recorders with no motors, belts or wheels

Digital recorders are 'solid state'. Apart from the necessary buttons, there are no moving parts. So no motors to wear out or run slow. No belts to break or wheels to run down. No chance of dirt ruining a recording. You simply press 'record' and produce a first class, clear recording each and every time.

Solid state memory gives hours of recordings

Tapes are usually limited to a few minutes recording. Digital allows you hours and hours – without the annoyance of changing tapes.

Long battery life

A digital recorder has no motors to consume battery power. So not only can the batteries in a digital recorder be smaller, but they'll also last much longer too.

Compactness

Digital recorders are much more compact than their analogue counterparts. So that's less bulk in your briefcase, pocket or handbag. Less space taken up on your desktop. And if it's less bulky, you're more likely to have your digital
